# Annual Club Gift Campaign



Each year, the Kiwanis International Foundation conducts its Annual Club Gift Campaign from October 1 through September 30, to provide the Foundation with an unrestricted source of income. Results totaled US\$7,000 when the program began in 1968. Proceeds now exceed US\$650,000 per year.



Contributions to the Annual Club Gift Campaign of US\$5 per member help the Kiwanis International Foundation meet the needs of children worldwide through grants, scholarships, and disaster relief. Your Kiwanis International Foundation to date has contributed more than US\$68 million to directly help children lead happy, healthy, and productive lives.

# Supporting **Children** worldwide

Recent grants awarded by your Foundation include:

**Kiwanis Club of Bowling Green Noon, Ohio—Kiwanis Kids Club project:** To provide supplies and equipment for a developmentally appropriate play space designed for young children at the Kiwanis Kids Club in the local community center. The Kiwanis Kids Clubhouse program services are designed to encourage basic fitness skills and prepare young children for a healthy life.

**Kiwanis Club of El Salvador Del Mundo—Villa Kiwanis project:** This grant will equip and furnish a school for elementary education and a medical clinic. The school will be equipped with shelves, computers, desks, chairs, books and sports equipment. The clinic will be supplied with beds, medicine cabinets, and medical supplies.

**Kiwanis Club of Golden Eagles, Oregon—New Beginnings project:** This program provides filled diaper bags to help many new needy moms get a good start in life with their newborns. The bags are filled with receiving blankets, general baby products, and a gift certificate to a local resale store for baby supplies.

**Kiwanis Club Northshore, Louisiana—Kids Konnection project:** This project will help create a handicap-accessible playground to enable all children to play and interact in a safe and positive environment. This playground will provide 70 percent accessibility and incorporate a variety of play stations to build cognitive, social, motor, and sensory skills. Play stations will include opportunities for sand and water play, music, climbing, balancing, swinging, and imaginary play.

**Kiwanis Austria District—Akamasoa Hospital project:** This grant will provide an ultrasound (sonogram) machine and a microscope for the laboratory for the Kiwanis Austria Akamasoa Hospital in Antananarivo/Madagascar.
